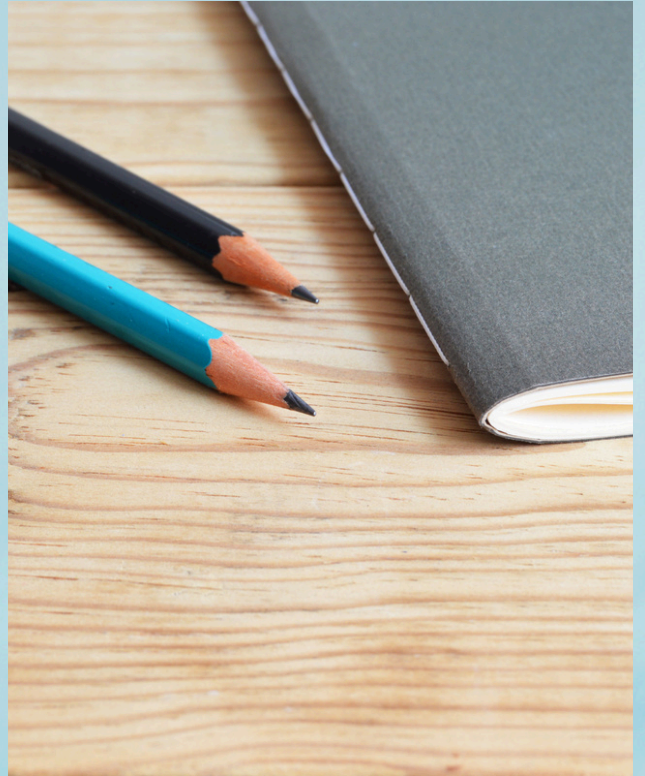

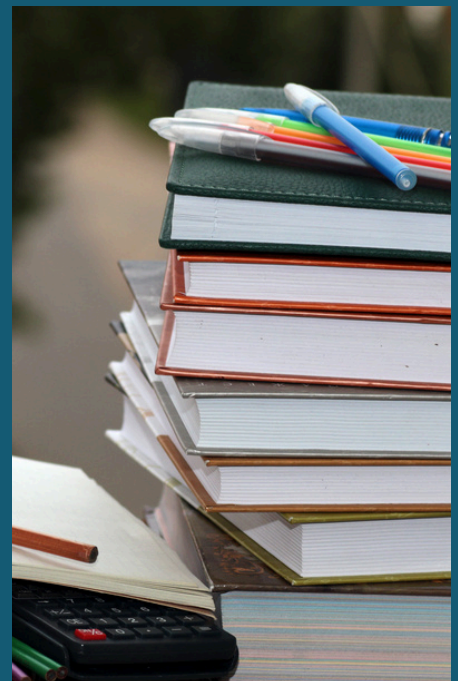

IMPORTANT

- Only the marks of General Studies I, General Studies II and Essay Paper are added to prepare the merit list for mains i.e. the mains exam consists of total 900 marks.
- It will be mandatory to score 30 percent marks in General Hindi, but these marks is not counted for the purpose of determining merit.
- It will be mandatory to score minimum marks determined by the BPSC in the optional paper i.e. General Category-40%, Backward Class-36.5%, Extremely Backward Class-34%, Scheduled Class/Tribe, Women and Physically Handicapped-32%. The marks obtained in optional paper will not be counted for determining the merit.

BPSC PRELIMS SYLLABUS

- Current Events of national and international importance.
- History of India and salient features of History of Bihar, Indian National Movement and Role of Bihar. Questions about the nature and character of the 19th century resurgence, nationalism growth and independence attainment with special emphasis on Bihar.
- General Science
- General Geography (including Physical, Social and Economic Geography) and geographical division of Bihar and its major river systems.
- Indian Polity:- Indian Political system, Community Development Panchayati Raj and Planning in India and Bihar.
- Indian Economy, Major changed in the economy of Bihar in the post-independence period.
- General Mental Ability.

BPSC INTERVIEW

- Candidates who have qualified BPSC Mains Exam are called for the Interview. The objective of conducting Interview is to check the personal suitability of the candidate in the state civil services. BPSC Interview consists of 120 marks.
- Thereafter, the marks of Mains and Interview are added to prepare the final merit list (out of 1020 marks)

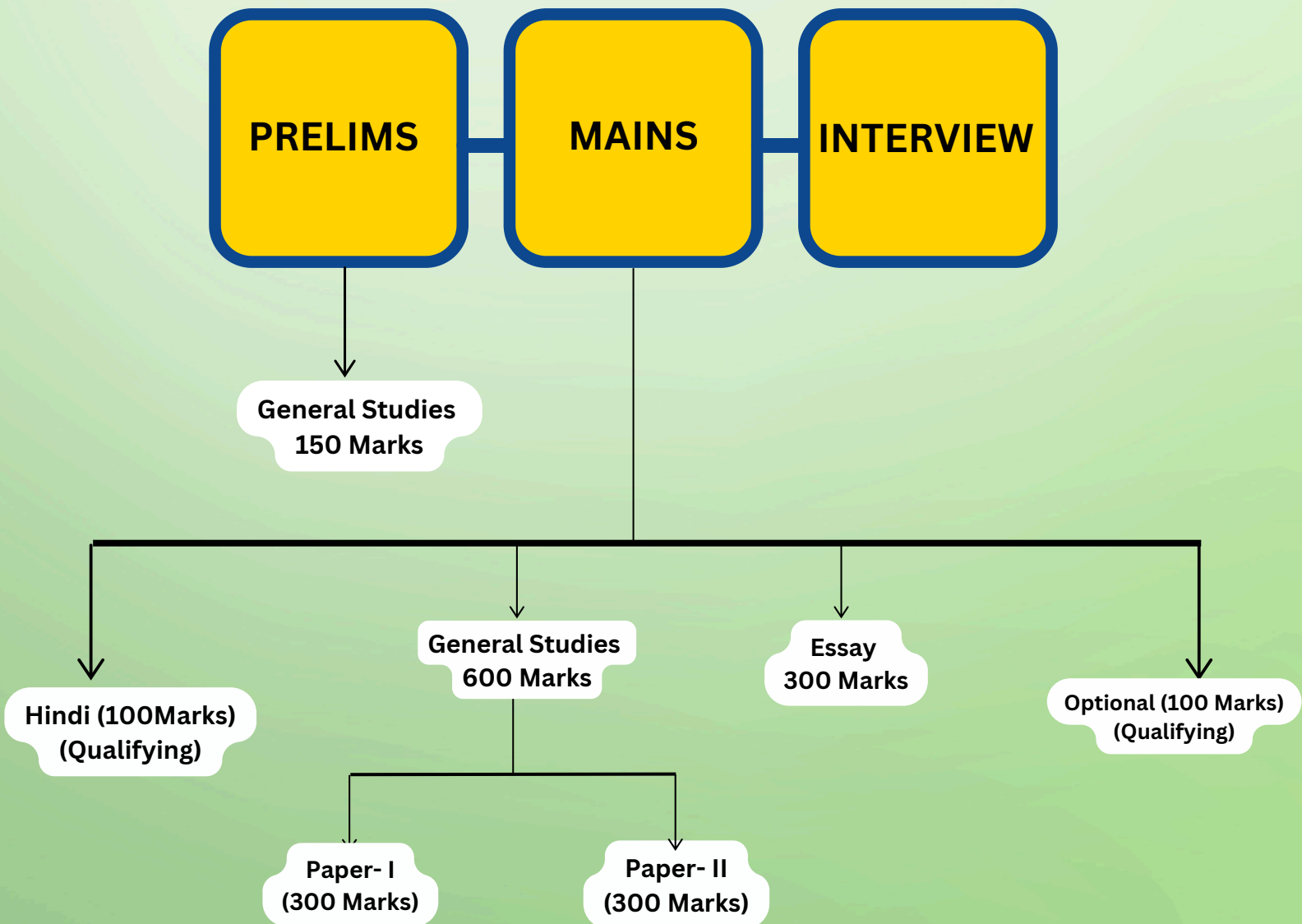
